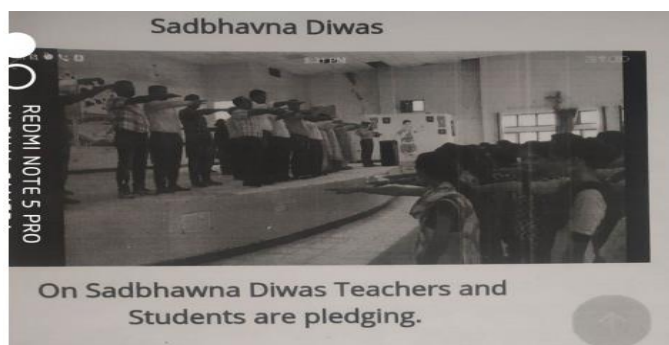

Independence Day celebration: on 15 August, 2019 Independence Day was celebrated by the flag hoisting in the college ground. All the staff members were present in this celebration.

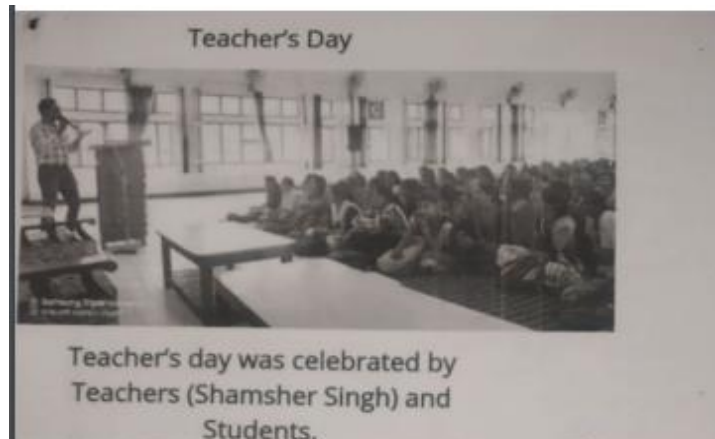

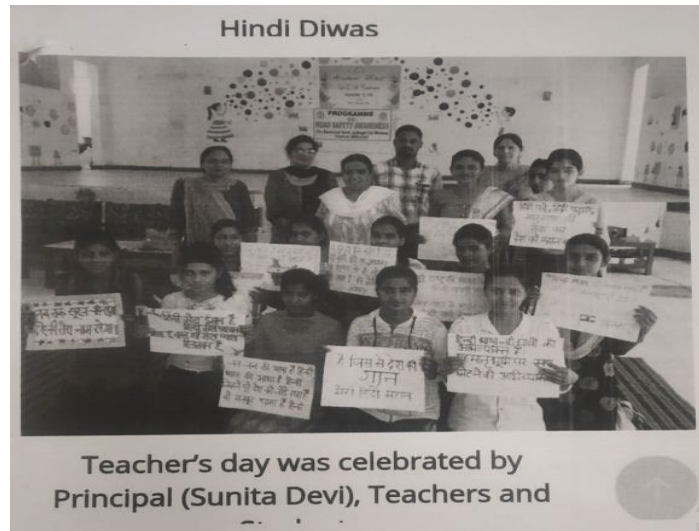

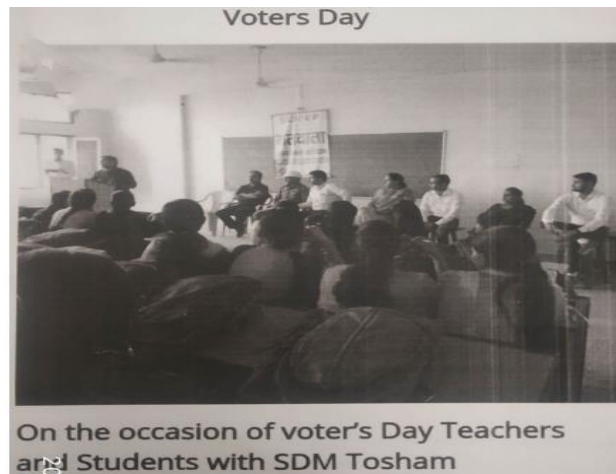


Hindi Divas was celebrated on 14 September, 2019 in presence of all the staff members and principal.
