According to the 2018 report of the World Health Organization, the highest numbers of road accidents occur in India worldwide. Even China, the most populous country, is behind us in this regard. As per the report of the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways, 2017, there are about 5 lakh road accidents occurred in India every year in which around 1.5 lakh people are killed. There are around 1.49 lakh people died in 2018 in the road accidents with Uttar Pradesh registering the maximum spike in fatalities.
